Fall season is now under way. Please remember that the qualifying score to state for level 3's is 33 AA and 4's and 5's it is 32 AA. That has not changed. What has changed is effective August 1, 2017, The mobility scores through the JO Program are the following:

Level 4 to Level 5 – 34.00

Level 5 to Level 6 or 7 – 32.00

Level 6 to Level 7 – 32.00

Level 7 to Level 8 – 32.00

Some other changes coming our way:
